\$2,000 to \$15,000 (renewable)

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Need is prioritized according to a Student Loan Burden score

ACADEMIC STATUS

Must have completed an associate's degree or higher for a qualified program. A \$5k add-on is available if applicant is licensed (i.e. LCSW, LCPC, behavioral technician, etc.)

EMPLOYMENT **✓** STATUS

Must remain a full-time employee in the same community-based human services org for at least 12 months after receiving this repayment grant
